Set up MFA in Attend Anywhere

Quickstart guide for service providers who want to use **Microsoft Authenticator** on their **Android** phone. You'll need an Attend Anywhere account on your computer and an Android phone.



On your phone, install <u>Microsoft</u>
<u>Authenticator</u> app from the Play Store.

Open the app and skip the first 3 screens until you see **Let's add your first account!**



On your computer, open <u>Attend</u>
<u>Anywhere</u>. You might need to sign in.

From the main menu, click your initials or profile image.

Click MFA Settings...



In the panel which appears, click **Turn on MFA**.

Leave the window open on your computer so that you can see the QR code (the checkered pattern of squares).



On you phone, in Microsoft Authenticator, tap the circular blue **QR code** button.

If you cannot see the button, do one of:


- Tap Add account.
- Tap + in the top bar.

Next, tap Other (Google, Facebook, etc.)




Point your phone at the Attend Anywhere QR code on your computer screen.

Position the code inside the scan box.



Tap the new Attend-Anywhere account that Microsoft Authenticator adds.

The app shows a 6-digit security code which is only valid for 30 seconds. Each time you sign in (and in the next step), you'll use a code.



On your computer, add the code to **Enter** the 6-digit code and click **Continue**.

Download the backup codes—useful when you can't access your phone. Click **Done**.
